Messianic Prophecy Series "The Scarlet Thread of Redemption" Part Two December 4, 2011

1. The Way P

Prophecy Proclaimed: Isaiah 40:3-5, "A voice of one calling: *"In the desert prepare the way for the Lord; make straight in the wilderness a highway for our God. Every valley shall be raised up, every mountain and hill made low; the rough ground shall become level, the rugged places a plain. And the glory of the Lord will be revealed, and all mankind together will see it. For the mouth of the Lord has spoken."*

How gracious God was to Zacharias and Elizabeth! **Luke 1:13-14**, "But the angel said to him: 'Do not be afraid, Zechariah; your prayer has been heard. Your wife Elizabeth will bear you a son, and you are to give him the name John. He will be a joy and delight to you, and many will rejoice because of his birth.'" Jesus said in **Matthew 11:11**, "I tell you the truth: Among those born of women there has not risen anyone greater than John the Baptist."

Prophecy Fulfilled: *Matthew 3:1-3*, "In those days John the Baptist came, preaching in the Desert of Judea and saying, "Repent, for the kingdom of heaven is near." This is he who was spoken of through the prophet Isaiah: "A voice of one calling in the desert, 'Prepare the way for the Lord, make straight paths for him.'"

2. T

Prophecy Proclaimed: *Psalms 78:2-4*, "I will open my mouth in parables, I will utter hidden things, things from of old-- what we have heard and known, what our fathers have told us. We will not hide them from their children; we will tell the next generation the praiseworthy deeds of the Lord, his power, and the wonders he has done."

While Jesus was a great teacher, He was much more than that. We need to understand the full deity of Jesus Christ. He was not just a good man, a prophet, and a great teacher. Jesus Christ is God manifest in the flesh.

Prophecy Fulfilled: *Matthew 13:34-35*, "Jesus spoke all these things to the crowd in parables; he did not say anything to them without using a parable. So was fulfilled what was spoken through the prophet: "I will open my mouth in parables, I will utter things hidden since the creation of the world."

3. D and H

Prophecy Proclaimed: *Isaiah 61:1-3*, "The Spirit of the Sovereign Lord is on me, because the Lord has anointed me to preach good news to the poor. He has sent me to bind up the brokenhearted, to proclaim freedom for the captives and release from darkness for the prisoners, to proclaim the year of the Lord's favor and the day of vengeance of our God, to comfort all who mourn, and provide for those who grieve in Zion ..."

Jesus didn't heal everybody, but He will save everyone who calls upon His name.

John 20:30-31, "Jesus did many other miraculous signs in the presence of his disciples, which are not recorded in this book. But these are written that you may believe that Jesus is the Christ, the Son of God, and that by believing you may have life in his name."

Prophecy Fulfilled: Turn to Luke 4:16-21.

4. R by Men

Prophecy Proclaimed: *Isaiah 53:3*, "He was despised and rejected by men, a man of sorrows, and familiar with suffering. Like one from whom men hide their faces he was despised, and we esteemed him not."

He was the King of kings, yet the kings of this earth sought to kill Him.

He was the Sinless One, yet we condemned Him in our court. He had the power to raise the dead, yet we crucified Him. He laid aside His crown of gold, and we crowned Him with a crown of thorns.

His hands healed fevered brows, and our hands slapped His face.

He took spit and mixed it with the clay of the ground and opened a blind man's eyes. We spat in His face until He could hardly see. (Adrian Rogers)

But one day, "... every knee should bow ... every tongue should confess that Jesus Christ is Lord, to the glory of God the Father" (***Philippians 2: 10-11***).

Prophecy Fulfilled: *John 1:11*, "He came unto His own, and His own received Him not."

5. The T Entry

Prophecy Proclaimed: *Zechariah 9:9*, "Rejoice greatly, O Daughter of Zion! Shout, Daughter of Jerusalem! See, your king comes to you, righteous and having salvation, gentle and riding on a donkey, on a colt, the foal of a donkey."

See Daniel's prophecy in Dan. 9:25.
